- 4. Risk calculator results (SWOP, PCPT 2.0, etc.)

Evaluation Options:

- 1. Further biomarker evaluation
 - a. PSA free/total, 4K score, liquid biopsy, PCA3, etc.
- 2. Multiparametric MRI of prostate
- 3. Prostate Biopsy
